1. General statement

Section 269(a) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 states:

“Where the Registrar, on perusal of any document which a company is required to submit to the Registrar under the provisions of this Law, is of opinion that any information or explanation is necessary in order that such document may afford full particulars of the matter to which it purports to relate, the Registrar may, with written notice, call on the company submitting the document to furnish in writing such information or explanation within such time as the Registrar may specify in his notice.”

Section 269(e) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 states:

“If it is represented to the Registrar in materials placed before the Registrar by any contributory or creditor that the business of a company is carried on in fraud of its creditors or in fraud of persons dealing with the company or for a fraudulent purpose, the Registrar may, after giving the company an opportunity of being heard by written notice, call on the company for information or explanation on matters specified in the notice within such time as the Registrar may specify in the notice, and the provisions of sub-sections (b) and (d) of this section and section 270 shall apply to such notice. If upon investigation the Registrar is satisfied that any representation on which the Registrar has taken action under this sub-section is frivolous or vexatious, the Registrar shall disclose the identity of the informant to the company.”
